

## Emacs

<b>Function</b>	<b>Key</b>	<b>Explanation</b>
Open a File	Ctrl-x f	It prompts you for the name of the file
Save	Ctrl-x s	Prompts for the filename if it is not already specified
Exit	Ctrl-x c	Exit the emacs. Prompts to save the file if it is not already saved
Scroll Up	Ctrl-b Page-up	Scrolls one window up
Scroll down	Esc v Page-down	Scroll one window down (push Esc first then push v)
Move one word backward	Esc b	Push Esc first then push b
Move one work forward	Esc f	Push Esc first then push f
Move to the end of the line	Ctrl-e	
Move to the beginning of the line	Ctrl-a	
Move to the begging of the file	Esc <	
Move to the end of the file	Esc >	
Delete the letter on the cursor	Ctrl-d	
Delete the letter before the cursor	Backspace	
Delete the word after the cursor	Esc d	Delete the word and put it into a buffer
Delete from the cursor to the end of the line	Ctrl-k	Delete the text while putting it into a buffer
Delete from the end of the current sentence	Esc k	Delete the text while putting it into a buffer
Paste from buffer	Ctrl-y	Paste everything from the buffer
Undo	Ctrl Shift -
